



Guidelines for using Macromedia Freehand

Scale Your Project

Scale your project to equal: 1 inch = 1 foot

For example: for an 8 ft wide x 3 ft high banner, the document dimensions should be set to 8 in wide by 3 in high.

Set the Black Values

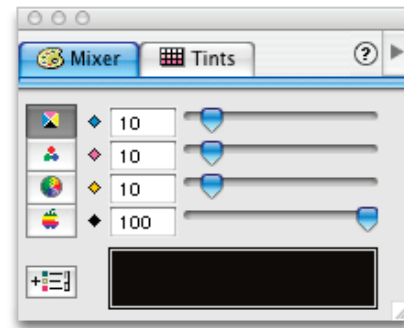
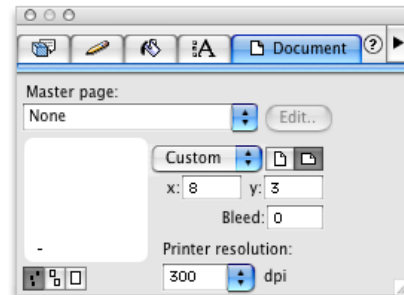
In order to get the richest blacks, make a swatch with the proper black settings and apply to all black elements. Open the Color Mixer (**Window->Colors->Color Mixer**) and set to the settings below. Click 'Add to Swatches' button on the Color Mixer palette to save.

Standard Settings

C = 10%
M = 10%
Y = 10%
K = 100%

Settings for fabriVue

Dye Sublimation
C = 0%
M = 0%
Y = 0%
K = 100%

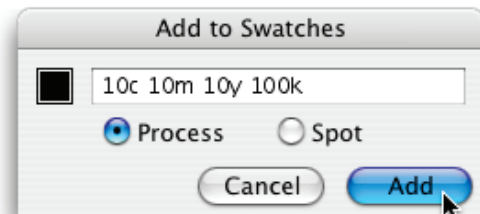


Convert your fonts to Paths

Convert all your type to paths before submitting your order. Select all the text in the document and choose **Text->Convert to Path**.

Saving The File

Save your file to the native **Freehand** format.

- File is in the correct scale of 1 inch = 1 foot.
- Colors must be in CMYK format. Make sure all Black values are set.
- All linked images are included with your document when uploading for print.
